A1 The PPCI service started in Jan 2009. The service was introduced in two phases:

- Phase one - Jan 2009 covering Royal Liverpool, Whiston and Aintree Hospitals
- Phase two - June 2010 covering Arrowe Park, Countess of Chester, Southport and Warrington Hospitals
