Subject: Whistleblowing Concerns During Covid-19 Pandemic

- Q1 Please provide the total number of whistleblowing concerns received between 01/03/2019 and 31/08/2019 by Liverpool Heart and Chest NHS Foundation Trust
- As a Trust we do not record 'whistleblowing' what we do record are Freedom To Speak Up (FTSU) cases. In line with national guidance our whistleblowing policy, became the Raising Concerns policy and then the Freedom to Speak Up Policy.

Often things that are raised under FTSU would not be classically considered 'whistleblowing' but expressions of concerns through the Freedom to Speak Up policy; in the spirit of FTSU we record them and escalate as per our policy.
