Subject: Mental Health - black and minority ethnic groups

I have the following national figure - amongst the five broad ethnic groups, known rates of detention for the 'Black or Black British' group (306.8 detentions per 100,000 population) were over four times those of the White group (72.9 per 100,000 population).

I'm looking at mental health and how it's treated at a local level. I would like to know the rate and percentage of detention, seclusion and diagnosis as psychosis for all BAME groups (including those mentioned below) compared to white patients for the Trust, in 2018/2019:
