Subject: Sleep apnoea - OSA & CPAP

- Q1 How many patients do you currently have on your sites, who have been diagnosed with sleep apnoea
- A1 Information not held The Trust does not routinely collate this data as part of its central management information.

The Trust provides a diagnostic service for obstructive sleep apnoea via an at home diagnostic sleep study. Following an outpatient attendance for this study, patients are either seen in clinic here at LHCH if the diagnosis is unclear or there is a need for them to be referred on for treatment to other appropriate Trusts. If there is no requirement for them to attend for a further outpatient appointment they are then referred back to their GP or source of referral for on-going management.
