- A2 Chief Finance Officer Finance, Estates and Digital Chief Information Officer IT and Business Intelligence only
- Q3 If the board level role has digital technology as part of their portfolio, please ask them to estimate what percentage of their time is spent on their digital technology role.
- A3 Information not held

Please note the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) gives rights of public access to information held by public authorities.
