- A3 On call commences 17:15 to 08:30am daily with 24hr cover Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays. 12 hour cover per on call period.
- Q4 Do you have separate Pacing/PPCI rotas on call?
- A4 No
- Q5 What rest periods do your staff get after being on call?
- A5 The staff have the day following an on call period as paid day off. If they have not been called out during their on call period this time is utilised as a PDR day. If departmental pressures are high and staff have not been called after midnight they could be asked to report for duty.

- A6 £11.52 for weekday, and £17.21 weekends
