Subject: Video Conferencing

- Q1 Do you have a video conferencing system for internal communications?
- A1 Yes please note we have chosen to provide response to this question although it is a general question rather than a request for information held by the Trust.

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) provides a right of access any recorded information held by a public authority and to be valid under Section 8 a request must:

- be in writing;
- include the requester's name and an address for correspondence
- describe the information being requested

Guidance issued by the Information Commissioner's Office states that a questionnaire/survey will qualify as an FOIA request provided that the requester has supplied their real name and an address, and at least one of the questions provides a valid description of the information being requested. However, authorities will need to treat each individual question on its merits which means adopting the following approach:

- Respond to any questions that provide a valid description of the information.
- For questions that are unclear, ask the requester for further clarification under Section 1(3).
- If any of the questions fail to meet the criteria for a valid description, issue the requester with a timely response advising that they are invalid under Section 8(1)(c) and explaining why.
- Q2 If yes, are there training programmes in place to ensure your staff can use the video conferencing system?
- A2 Information not held but we can advise local training provided
- Q3 How do multi-disciplinary teams communicate within the trust?
- As per A1, general question however, each MDT meeting may have different requirements so the methods used will vary accordingly
- Q4 Does the trust use the N3 video conferencing overlay service to book and schedule video calls?
- A4 Yes general question as per A1
- Q5 Will you have completed your transition from the N3 network to the new HSCN by the deadline of September 2019?
- A5 Completed in December 2018



- Q6 Does the trust plan to introduce virtual consultations or appointments via video in the near future?
- A6 Yes general question as per A1
