## **Multiple Inpatient/Daycase Procedures**

When a patient undergoes multiple procedures within the same admission then we will always seek to make this known to the patient before they are admitted and include it in the quotation provided.

In some situations this is not always possible, for example the additional procedures are not known in advance or the clinical condition of the patient changes during their admission. Wherever possible we will seek agreement in advance for additional treatment.

Our tariff for multiple procedures mirrors that used widely in the healthcare insurance field, and recognises that multiple procedures can provide cost savings over separate procedures.

#### Multiple procedures taking place in the same admission and the SAME theatre/cath lab sessions:

We will discount the second and subsequent procedure tariff to reflect the economies of scale in the ward and theatre costs:

- 100% of the tariff for the main procedure (which is the most expensive procedure)
- Then 50% of the tariff for the second procedure.
- Then 25% of the tariff for the third, and each subsequent procedure.

Devices for subsequent procedures that are not included in the main procedure tariff are charged separately.

#### Multiple procedures taking place in the same admission but in SEPARATE theatre/cath lab sessions:

We will discount the second and subsequent procedure tariff to reflect the economies of scale in the ward costs only:

- 100% of the tariff for the main procedure (which is the most expensive procedure)
- Then 75% of the tariff for the second procedure.
- Then 50% of the tariff for the third and each subsequent procedure.

Devices for subsequent procedures that are not included in the main procedure tariff are charged separately.

A confirmed price tailored to individual patient circumstances must be provided by the private patients team prior to arranging treatment.
