Subject: Mental health professional in diabetes service

- Q1 How many specialist adult diabetes multi-disciplinary teams operate within the Trust?
- A1 Nil We do not have a diabetes MDT. We have three Diabetes Specialist Nurses (2 permanent, 1 secondment post) and one Cystic Fibrosis Related Diabetes (CFRD) Advanced Nurse Practitioner and one CFRD Specialist Nurses.

We do have a multidisciplinary team that provide diabetes expertise to CF diabetic patients within the trust.

- Q2 How many people are currently under the care of each specialist adult diabetes multidisciplinary team within the trust?
- A2 Information not held as a tertiary centre the inpatient adult diabetes team do not have an active outpatient caseload. The CFRD team have 146 patients who they manage.
- Q3 How many whole time equivalent mental health professionals are employed as part of each specialist adult diabetes multi-disciplinary team, and which part of the service are they aligned to?

- A3 There are no mental health professionals employed specifically for inpatient adults with diabetes but the CF diabetic patients have access to psychology support as requested.
