1. Executive Summary

- The GMC/Deanery report was received on the 10th of January 2016.
- Attached was an action plan to address outstanding issues raised at the visit.
- This paper and attachments details the finalised action plan that was submitted to HENW and the GMC before the deadline of July 1st 2017

2. Background

The Trust has been under the GMC enhanced educational monitoring process since 2014.

HENW and GMC representatives performed their annual visit to review junior surgical doctor training on 23rd November 2016. This was a specific visit and not the biennial review of all training.

A considerable amount of work has gone into restructuring all aspects of junior doctor training and progress was acknowledged at the visit with particular praise for the improvements led by the surgical tutor and the educational supervisors..

The visiting team plan to lift enhanced monitoring after the next GMC survey. The report outlined an action plan to address any additional points. The issues and progress noted by the GMC required a response by July 1st 2017.

The DME and education team have completed the actions ahead of time and submitted the action plan. The HENW/GMC response is awaited.

4. Conclusion

The positive outcome of the visit in November is a testament to the efforts of the Trust in general and the DME/Medical Education team in particular.

The Medical Education team has made good progress in managing the outstanding issues raised by the GMC. The actions are now complete.
