1. Executive Summary

The Deanery report was received on the 19th of February 2016. Attached was an action plan to address outstanding issues raised at the visit. This paper and attachments detail progress to date demonstrating progress and compliance with deadlines.

2. Background

The Deanery and GMC representatives performed their annual visit to review junior doctor training on October 22nd 2015. The trust has been under enhanced monitoring by the GMC since the previous visit due to issues with surgical training.

A considerable amount of work has gone into restructuring all aspects of junior doctor training and progress was acknowledged at the visit in October.

A number of further issues were identified some of which were dealt with in an immediate response. The report received in February outlined an action plan to address outstanding items.

The issues raised by the GMC were responded to by March 31st 2016. There have been no issues raised thereafter. The remaining Deanery concerns were addressed by June 2016 and there has been no further response.

All of the actions will be complete well in advance of the next Deanery visit on 23rd November 2016.

3. Issues

These are itemised with appropriate actions on the appended action plan. Achievements and dates for final completion have been updated.

4. Conclusion

The Medical Education team are making good progress in managing the outstanding issues raised by the Deanery and the GMC.

5. Recommendations

The Board of Directors is asked to accept the action plan and note appropriate progress. The committee should be reassured over completion of the action plan and are asked to recognise the considerable on going work to improve training at LHCH.
