1. Introduction

The Trust's Provider Licence states that all Governors must be 'fit and proper persons' (as defined in condition G4) and sets out the criteria for compliance. Governors are required to complete a self-declaration on appointment and on an annual basis.

Governors were asked on 7th January 2020 to complete a Fit Proper Persons Self Declaration form (as attached).

20 out of a possible 23 Governors completed the annual self-declaration and the remaining annual self declarations will be obtained as soon as is reasonably possible.

2. Recommendations

The Council of Governors are asked to note that the Governor 'fit and proper persons' self-declarations have been received as noted above, and all confirmed the criteria as met.
