**Subject:** Information on Palantir's Federated Data platform

This is a Freedom of Information request for information relating to the letter this summer from Dame Emily Lawson and Vin Diwaker to all trust executives and COOs, asking them to confirm “that [they] plan to adopt the NHS FDP in the next two years”.

Q1 I would like to see all emails, documents, attachments, and any other forms of response relating to this request between the trust and the two senior NHS officials.

It is public information that you have been asked to inform the NHS when you “envisage adopting already available nationally commissioned local Products”.

A1 Information not held – no emails, documents, attachments, and any other forms of response relating to the national Federated Data Platform (FDP) between the Trust and NHS England (NHSE).

Q2 I would like to know when specifically you plan to start adopting the FDP and who you are naming as lead (as is requested in the letter)?

A2 The Trust is currently reviewing deployment timeframes with NHSE and governance arrangements for leads are still to be approved.

Q3 I would also like to know what your plans are for how you will maximise the benefits of the Federated Data Platform to deliver better joined-up care for their patients within the next two years (again, asked of you in the above mentioned letter)?

A3 Information not held - the Trust does not routinely collate or hold this information centrally as part of its management or performance data.
